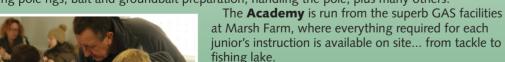

These vital skills extend into all spheres of angling... pole, waggler and feeder fishing. Our **Skills Gym** gives them a hands on challenge under the guidance of match organiser **Dave Johnson** and Coaching Development Coordinator **Dave Ewing**. Each has



extensive knowledge of all forms of angling that juniors require. They cover such topics as making pole rigs, bait and groundbait preparation, handling the pole, plus many others.



Our special training facility extends to a purpose built and stocked lake – Hill Pond.

The dates for 2017 started on February 16th and two more follow on the 14th April (Good Friday)

and Tuesday 30th May. With the February session already finished by the time this Newsletter arrives with you, the April and May sessions will all be about Hooks/hooklengths and waggler fishing respectively.

2017 Summer Coaching Programme



Do you want to try fishing for the first time... or do you fish already and want to improve, with the help of our highly experienced coaches?

Our summer coaching programme is what you need!

Every second Saturday from June 10th, right through to September, we run coaching sessions at Marsh Farm from 9am to 12 noon.

There are two coaching groups:

Start2Fish is our beginners group. Based on Hill Pond, we will teach you how to land fish, hook different baits and how to feed correctly, so you get more bites.

Led by Kevin Holcombe, a fully qualified Level 2 angling instructor, these sessions are great fun and fantastic for those just starting out in angling.

All tackle and bait is provided and sessions are FREE.

Please note: A parent or responsible adult does need to stay with children for these sessions.

Learn AFish sessions are for more experienced anglers looking to improve. Run on Richardson Lake and led by two highly qualified anglers, Trevor Haskell and Paul Chudyk. Paul is a former England disabled international angler and Trevor brings a wealth of experience and is a top Marsh Farm match angler. Sessions are FREE and run from 9 till 1pm. You will need to bring your own fishing tackle for these sessions.
